Notice to High School graduating Seniors from Culpeper County Public Schools

The Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins Scholarship has been established to assist members of Culpeper United Methodist Church who have resided in the Town of Culpeper or Culpeper County for at least four (4) years and attended either Culpeper County or Eastern View High School for their four (4) years of high school. This scholarship is for CUMC members attending their first year of advanced studies beyond high school and attending either a private or public university in the State of Virginia.

- The Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins scholarship applications will be available at the beginning of February each year by contacting the church office.
- The Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins scholarship reminders will be published in the Culpeper United Methodist Church Chimes for the month of February, March and April. Reminders will also be published in the Sunday bulletin during the months of April and March as well.
- The Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins Scholarship will award up to a \$1000.00 scholarship to one (1) eligible and approved recipient from Culpeper County High School and one (1) eligible and approved recipient from Eastern View High School.
- The Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins Scholarship applicant must be attending a private or public university in the State of Virginia.
- The Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins Scholarship will be based on greatest financial need and merit.
- The Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins Scholarship recipient will be notified by letter or email as soon as possible.
- The Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins Scholarship recipient will receive their award on Sunday, June 2.



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Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins Scholarship Award Criteria for Consideration

- The application for the Winfred & Pamela H. Eddins Scholarship shall be completed and submitted using the format application from Culpeper United Methodist Church. The completed application should be typed & all supporting information requested in the guidelines stated below must be mailed/delivered to the attention of the "Scholarship Chair" of Culpeper United Methodist Church. The completed package must be received by Culpeper United Methodist Church by the end of closing of normal office hours on Friday, April 26th.
- The applicant must be a member of Culpeper United Methodist Church.
- The applicant must have resided in either the Town of Culpeper or Culpeper County for the last four (4) years.
- The applicant must have attended all four (4) years of high school at either Culpeper County or Eastern View High School and will graduate from either Culpeper County or Eastern View High School.
- The applicant must have a "B" academic average or better and submit an official transcript from their high school.
- The applicant must have a sealed letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, coach or guidance counselor.
- The applicant must have a sealed letter of recommendation from a CUMC member outside their own family.
- The applicant must provide a list of school and community activities and/or affiliation with a description explaining their participation and/or achievements.
- A 150-200 word essay or letter submitted by a parent or guardian stating their student's need for financial assistance.
- A 150-200 word essay submitted by the applicant stating his or her future educational goals and aspirations for the future.

- A 150-200 word essay submitted by the applicant stating his or her future educational goals and aspirations for the future.
