## Printz Family Scholarship Award

### *Notice to High School graduating Senior's with a financial need*

- The Printz Family Scholarship has been established to assist qualified applicants who without financial assistance would be unable to pursue higher education.
- The Printz Family scholarship applications will be available at the beginning of February each year by contacting the church office or through the guidance office at Culpeper County or Eastern View High Schools.
- The Printz Family scholarship reminders will be published in the Culpeper United Methodist Church Chimes for the months of February, March, and April. Reminders will also be published in the Sunday bulletin during the months of March and April.
- The Printz Family Scholarship will award up to \$1000.00 scholarship to two (2) eligible and approved recipients each year.
- The Printz Family Scholarship will be based on greatest financial need and merit.
- The Printz Family Scholarship recipient will be notified by letter or email as soon as possible.
- The Printz Family Scholarship recipient will receive their award on Sunday, June 4.



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## Printz Family Scholarship Award Criteria for Consideration

- The application for the Printz Family Scholarship shall be completed and submitted using the format application from Culpeper United Methodist Church. The completed application should be typed & all supporting information requested in the guidelines stated below **must be mailed/delivered** to the attention of the “Scholarship Chair” of Culpeper United Methodist Church. The completed package must be received by Culpeper United Methodist Church by the end of closing of normal office hours at Culpeper United Methodist Church on Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup>.
- The applicant must be a resident of the Town of Culpeper or the County of Culpeper.
- The applicant must have at least a “B” academic average and submit an official transcript from their high school.
- The applicant must have a sealed letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, coach or guidance counselor.
- The applicant must provide a list of school and community activities and/or affiliation with a description explaining their participation and/or achievements.
- A 150-200 word essay or letter submitted by a parent or guardian stating their student’s need for financial assistance.
- A 150-200 word essay submitted by the applicant stating his or her future educational goals & aspirations for the future.

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## Printz Family Scholarship Award Checklist for Submission

- An Official transcript from high school attended

- A 150-200 word essay or letter submitted by the parent or guardian stating their need for financial assistance.
- A 150-200 word essay submitted by the applicant stating his or her future educational goals & aspirations for the future.
